

Payment for Term 4 Fees

We want to ensure that your child has the best possible experience at WAGs, so this is our process around securing your place in a class. This will help us provide the appropriate number of coaches, spaces and equipment.

The process is as follows:

- Check the Returner Folder on the foyer table and mark if your child is returning or not.
- The gymnasts place will then be secured on the roll and an invoice for Term 3 will emailed out to you by the end of the first week of the holidays in October.
- Invoices are required to be paid by the end of week 1 in Term 4 <u>19th October</u> unless by prior arrangement
- If payment is not received, the gymnast will be taken off the roll to allow the waiting list and new enrolments a chance to enrol. All late payments will incur a \$15 late payment fee.
